ORDINANCE No. 187312

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for Right of Way Services to define roles and responsibilities regarding the use of real property for construction of public improvements related to the Red Electric Trail Project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In September 2011, City Council executed an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Red Electric Trail Project: SW 30th SW Vermont via Ordinance No. 184888, (Grant TR000183).
- 2. This supplemental Right of Way Services Agreement outlines the Bureau of Transportation's obligations for acquiring the right-of-way necessary to construct the project with federal funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for Right of Way Services, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.
