Purpose of proposed legislation and background information: This legislation authorizes Portland Parks & Recreation to accept federal grant funds from the Oregon Department of Education, and to enter into a price agreement with Centennial School District, in order to provide meals to children attending afterschool programs at St. Johns, Charles Jordan and Peninsula Park Community Centers. PP&R is a sponsor of an Afterschool At-Risk Meal and Snack Program, which allows the Bureau to receive federal reimbursement for costs associated with serving meals to children attending programs in neighborhoods where hunger and food insecurity are prevalent.

**Financial and budgetary impacts** This legislation allows PP&R to accept federal funds in the amount of approximately \$30,000. Actual amount will vary depending on program enrollment and number of reimbursable meals served.
