TO THE COUNCIL:

On April 15, 2015, Council approved Ordinance #187090 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Hollywood-Grant Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000050 on behalf of the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) with a project construction estimate of \$9,500,000.00. BES rated the project estimate confidence level as High.

Bids were opened on July 7, 2015, and six (6) bids were received. The low bid of Emery & Sons Construction Group was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that Emery & Sons' bid be accepted at the estimated unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$10,995,653.00.

BES along with Procurement Services identified seven (7) Divisions of Work as potential subcontracting opportunities for this project resulting in \$3,038,596.00 awarded to subcontractors.

MWESB participation represents 31.43% or \$955,000.00 of the total construction cost:

- MBE \$75,000.00 performing Concrete Cutting
- WBE \$800,000.00 performing Hauling Services (Trucking) (partial)
- ESB \$80,000.00 performing Traffic Control Services (Includes TPDT) (partial)

Emery & Sons Construction Group is located in Salem, Oregon and is not a State Certified Contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available in the Bureau of Environmental Services Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2015 Budget, WBS Element E10384.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
