ORDINANCE No. 187320

* Accept and appropriate an additional award in the amount of \$8,000 from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the FY2015 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau accepted a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) in the amount of \$37,500 for the FY2015 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program in February 2015 with the passing of Ordinance 187029; and
- 2. ODOT has notified the City that it will grant an additional \$8,000 for the FY2015 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program to the Police Bureau; and
- 3. The additional dollars will fund the Police Bureau Traffic Division's overtime expenses associated with this program; and
- 4. ODOT will reimburse the City a new maximum of \$45,500 for sworn personnel overtime hours worked on the program; and
- 5. Local match is required by matching straight-time hours, which will be funded by existing bureau General Fund appropriation.
- 6. The grant period is January 15, 2015 through September 30, 2015; and
- 7. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would impede the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant with these additional dollars within the grant period.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate an additional \$8,000 on behalf of the City of Portland from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the FY2015 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program.
- b. The FY 2015-16 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217
Business Area - PL
Bureau Program Expenses - \$8,000

c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would impede the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant with these additional dollars. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
