## ORDINANCE NO.

\* Pay claim of Pacific Mobile Structures, Inc. in the sum of \$13,400 involving the Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In 1998, the Police Bureau rented a Blazer 10 X 40 office trailer from Pacific Mobile Structures, Inc. (Pacific Mobile).
- 2. Pacific Mobile has made a claim for damages related to the trailer.
- 3. Settlement of Pacific Mobile's claim is in the city's interest.
- 4. Pacific Mobile and the city have agreed on a settlement value of \$13,400 and Pacific Mobile has signed a hold harmless agreement.
- 5. Sufficient funding is available in the existing FY 2015-16 Police Bureau appropriation to settle the claim.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$13,400 made payable to Pacific Mobile.
- b. The Police Bureau is authorized to execute a payment in the amount set forth in subparagraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
