Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance will close OMF Risk Management file No. 2014-000509-30, which arises from bodily injury to Norman Bailey as a result of a motor vehicle accident that occurred on March 25, 2014 in North Portland.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This legislation will have no impact on City revenue. Total cost to the City is \$11,000.00. The source of funding is the City's Insurance and Claims Fund. All cost of the settlement is in the current fiscal year. This Ordinance does not amend the budget.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This Ordinance settles a tort claim resulting from a motor vehicle accident between Norman Bailey and a Parks Bureau employee in North Portland. The settlement includes medical bill reimbursement and general damages.

No public involvement or input was sought regarding the Ordinance. The City Attorney's Office and Risk Management have concluded that it is not appropriate to have public involvement in settlement negotiations regarding tort claims or lawsuits against the City.

No future public involvement is anticipated or necessary. Approval by City Council of this Ordinance will fully resolve this tort claim against the City of Portland.
