

## **ORDINANCE No. 187331**

\* Authorize application to the Oregon Department of Justice Crime Victims' Services Division for a grant in the amount of \$96,946 for the Police Bureau Crisis Response Team in order to reimburse the City for 46 percent of the volunteer coordinator personnel expenses over a 24-month period (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon Department of Justice (ODOJ) is the designated agency for the administration of Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) funds in Oregon. The ODOJ Crime Victims' Services Division (CVSD) makes awards to organizations that provide direct services to victims of crime. The money for these grants comes from the Crime Victims Fund, a special fund into which fines and penalty assessments are collected from convicted federal offenders;
2. The City of Portland, Oregon, Police Bureau wishes to apply for \$96,946 in grant funding, which if awarded, will reimburse the City for 46 percent of the personnel expenses for the Crisis Response Team's senior administrative specialist/volunteer coordinator over a 24-month period;
4. Local match in the amount of \$24,236.50 will be provided by funds from existing Police Bureau appropriations within the Youth Services Division in Fiscal Years 2016, 2017, and 2018;
5. The grant period is October 1, 2015, through September 30, 2017; and
6. An emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this application may result in not receiving ODOJ grant funding.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to ODOJ CVSD for a grant in the amount of \$96,946.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this application may result in not receiving funding. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
