

Ordinance No. 5606

An ordinance accepting certain property for the construction of the East 33rd Street Viaduct, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for street purposes.

Beginning at the intersection of the east line of East 33rd Street North with the southerly line of Columbia Slough Road; thence south 75 degrees and 31 minutes east, along said southerly line of Columbia Slough Road, 250.05 feet to a point; thence south 14 degrees 29 minutes west 20 feet to a point; thence north 75 degrees 31 minutes west, parallel to the southerly line of said Columbia Slough Road, 52.85 feet to a point; thence north 85 degrees 02 minutes west 115.54 feet to the beginning of a curve to the left, radius 69 feet central angle 75 degrees and 18 minutes; thence along the arc of said curve 90.68 feet to a point on the east line of said East 33rd Street North 104.19 feet southerly from the place of beginning; thence north 0 degrees 04 minutes east, along said east line, 104.19 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning. Tax Lot 54 of Section 13, T. 1N. R. 1E; W.M. for 1928 except that portion taken for widening of East 33rd Street North of Columbia Slough Road. (Deeded by Rudolph Schneider and Susana Schneider, his wife)

Tract No. 1 Sunderland Acres (Deeded by John B. Moore and Bertha J. Moore, his wife)

Section 2. That the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to have the deeds to the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this; it is necessary that this property be immediately opened to the public for the construction of the East 33rd Street Viaduct; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
