Authorize contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the construction of the SE Powell Recon Sewer & Green Streets project E08659 for \$3,730,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
 - 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to furnish material and labor along with the City's Purchasing department, to advertise and award the project E08659 SE Powell Recon Sewer & Green Street Project to lowest responsible bidder.
 - 2. BES has prepared plans, specifications and estimates to construct the SE Powell Recon Sewer & Green Streets. Approximately 4,508 feet of failing or undersized sewers need to be reconstructed to maintain standard service to existing customers. Also the proposed 22 Green Street facilities will remove stormwater from the system.
 - 3. The estimated cost is \$3,730,000. Level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E08659.C60.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract for the purpose described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$3,730,000.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
