Ordinance No. 58801

An ordinance to change and re-establish the curb lines of 50th Avenue Southeast, from the center line of 64th Street Southeast produced north to the center line of 67th Street Southeast, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable so as to agree with existing improvement in the contemplated improvement of 50th Avenue Southeast, from the center line of 64th Street Southeast produced north to the center line of 67th Street Southeast, to widen the roadway from 20 feet in width as now established by Ordinance No. 51346 to 22.5 feet in width, therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the curb lines of 50th Avenue Southeast, from the center line of 64th Street Southeast produced north to the center line of 67th Street Southeast, be and the same are hereby changed and re-established at 11.25 feet distant from and parallel to the center line of said 50th Avenue Southeast.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: that there be no undue delay in completing the improvement work on this street during this season; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
