

Ordinance No. 59152

An ordinance accepting certain easement for the relocation of the East 1st Street Sewer, between East Irving Street and East Glisan Street, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described easement be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for sewer purposes:

Beginning at a point in the center line of the present eight (8) inch sewer of the City of Portland on the southerly extension of the center line of East 1st Street, two hundred ninety-eight and one tenth (298.1) feet south of the center line of East Irving Street when measured along said southerly extension of the center line of East 1st Street; thence southwesterly along a straight line, deflection angle of forty-six degrees twenty minutes ( $46^{\circ}21'$ ) to the right from said southerly extension, a distance of sixty four and three tenths (64.3) feet to a point; thence southeasterly along a straight line, deflection angle of ninety degrees ( $90^{\circ}$ ) to the left from the last described course, a distance of eighty-eight (88) feet to a point in the center line of said present eight (8) inch sewer of the City of Portland. (Deeded by the O-W.R.R.& N. Company)

Section 2. That the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to have the easement for right of way described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: It is necessary that the easement be accepted at once because of the relocation of the East 1st Street Sewer; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
