Ordinance No. 59401

An ordinance accepting certain property for the widening of the intersection of 50th Avenue Southeast and 66th Street Southeast, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for street purposes:

Beginning at the northeast corner of lot 10, block 6, Third Electric Addition; thence west along the north line of said lot 10 a distance of 28 feet to a point; thence southeasterly to a point on the easterly line of said lot 10, said point lying 28 feet south of the place of beginning, measured along said easterly line; thence north to the place of beginning. (Deeded by School District #1, Multnomah County, Oregon)

Section 2. That the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to have the deed to the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: It is necessary that this property be immediately opened to the public for the widening of the intersection of 50th Avenue Southeast and 66th Street Southeast; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
