

Ordinance No. 59548

An Ordinance declaring Twenty-first Street from Washington Street to Salmon Street and Taylor Street from King Street to Twenty-first Street as legally established street areas and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it appears that Twenty-first Street from Washington Street to Salmon Street and Taylor Street from King Street to Twenty-first Street have been established as city streets by use thereof for over a period of ten years and have been recognized by property owners as streets and improved under private permits, and in order to establish a definite record; now therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described street area, to-wit,

Beginning at a point on the south line of Washington Street 30 feet west when measured at right angles of its intersection with the center line of that part of Twenty-first Street lying north of Washington Street extended south; thence south thirty feet from and parallel with said center line of Twenty-first Street extended south to its intersection with the north line of Salmon Street to the north line of said Salmon Street; thence east along said north line of Salmon Street to a point thirty feet east of the said center line of Twenty-first Street when measured at right angles; thence north 30 feet from and parallel with said center line of Twenty-first Street to the south line of Washington Street; thence west along said south line of Washington Street 60 feet to point of beginning,

is hereby declared to be the street area of Twenty-first Street from Washington Street to Salmon Street.

Section 2. That the following described street area, to-wit,

Beginning at a point on the east line of King Street 260.15 feet north of its intersection with the northerly line of Salmon Street; thence south $76^{\circ}16'$ east 247.76 feet to a point; thence north $1^{\circ}27'$ west 62.17 feet; thence north $76^{\circ}16'$ west 247.76 feet to the east line of King Street; thence southerly along said east line of King Street 62.17 feet to point of beginning,

is hereby declared to be the street area of Taylor Street

from King Street to Twenty First Street

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That proceedings are contemplated for the improvement of said streets and the construction of sewers therein and in order to clear up the record as to whether or not said areas are actual streets, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
