

Ordinance No. 59644

An Ordinance to amend section 1 of Ordinance No. 45614, relating to zoning, by changing from Zone II to Zone III lots 2 and 3, block 179, Couch's Addition, Portland, Oregon.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That section 1 of Ordinance No. 45614, entitled, "An Ordinance dividing the City of Portland into four districts, prescribing the uses to which property in such districts may be put or used, providing for the establishment of building set-back lines, providing a penalty for violation thereof, and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith", passed by the Council September 24, 1924, and approved by the legal voters of the City of Portland November 4, 1924, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a paragraph to be hereafter known as subdivision (235) of section 1, reading as follows:

(235) The following described property, to wit: Lots 2 and 3, block 179, Couch's Addition, in the City of Portland, county of Multnomah, state of Oregon, shall be in Zone III, and the auditor is hereby directed to change the maps provided for in section 1 of this ordinance by designating on said maps said real property as being in Zone III.
