

**ORDINANCE No. 187346**

\* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$2,500 from the Regional Arts & Culture Council for the Portland Disability Storytelling Project, a project of the Portland Commission on Disability (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. The Office of Equity and Human Rights applied to the Regional Arts & Culture Council for a grant in the amount of \$2,500 for the Portland Disability Storytelling Project on June 23, 2015; and
2. The Regional Arts & Culture Council has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Portland Disability Storytelling Project to the Office of Equity and Human Rights in the amount of \$2,500;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Regional Arts & Culture Council for the Portland Disability Storytelling Project in the amount of \$2,500 and to execute the grant agreement.
- b. The FY 2015/2016 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217

Business Area – OE

Bureau Program Expenses– \$2,500

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Office of Equity and Human Rights of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Regional Arts & Culture Council for the Expanding Cultural Access Grant, ECAFY201500023, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


