ORDINANCE No. 187347

*Amend contract with Portland Patrol, Inc. to provide security coverage to the Portland Streetcar Facility for \$75,000 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002191)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City entered into a contract with Portland Patrol, Inc. on July 15, 2011 to provide security services through June 30, 2012 in the six (6) City-owned SmartPark garages.
- 2. The contract time was extended to June 30, 2016 through Amendment 1 by Ordinance No. 185272 on April 25, 2012.
- 3. The amount of the contract, as increased by Amendment 1, Ordinance No. 185272, was \$3,079,000.
- 4. Security coverage is now needed at the Streetcar Facility to deter criminal activity. This is to ensure both public and employee safety as well as deter property damage.
- 5. This contract is being amended by \$75,000 bringing the total Contract amount to \$3,154,000 through Fiscal Year 2015-2016.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No. 30002191 with Portland Patrol, Inc., in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to Portland Patrol, Inc., chargeable to the Streetcar & Transit Partnerships Division.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of the need for on-site security; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


