




#### **Licensing Scenario 1**

Exception for Medical Dispensaries operating prior to 1/1/15 does NOT apply

- Dispensary 1 registered and operating in compliance since 2014
- Dispensary 2 registered since March 2015
- Retail 1 new outlet, not operating
- All applications can be approved for local license. Order of receipt of application does not matter because all meet minimum standards including 1000 ft requirement.
- Dispensary 1 or 2 could relinquish dispensary license and convert to retail in their existing location in 2016.






NOTE - Red Dashed Circles represent 1000 ft radius/buffer

#### **Licensing Scenario 2**

Exception for Medical Dispensaries operating prior to 1/1/15 DOES apply

- Retail 1 Application received by City first – December 1, 2015. Meets minimum standards and is approved.
- Dispensary 1 registered and operating in compliance since 2014, application received by City by January 2016. Approved under exception 14B.130.040 D.2
- Retail 1 and Dispensary 1 under separate ownership
- Dispensary 1 can maintain license as medical dispensary annually, but cannot convert to Retail since existing Retail within 1000 ft.
- Dispensary 1 maintains supply for medical patients.
- Meets Council intent to preserve existing dispensaries but avoid saturation of consumer marijuana establishments.

### **Licensing Scenario 3**

Exception for Medical Dispensaries operating prior to 1/1/15 does NOT apply

- Retail 1 Application received by City first – December 1, 2015. Meets minimum standards and is approved.
- Dispensary 1 registered and operating in compliance since 2014.
  However, application received on January 15, 2015.
- Exception does not apply since both locations under same ownership and located within 1000 ft of each other.
- Owner must decide whether to relinquish Retail and proceed with Dispensary or vice versa.
- Section 14B.130.040 D.2.d intended to prevent use of the exception process to circumvent the 1000 ft rule and saturate the area with consumer marijuana establishments.
- Meets Council intent to preserve existing dispensaries but avoid saturation of consumer marijuana establishments.
