## Ordinance No. 61171

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to purchase parts for the repair of American La France Apparatus in the open market, without advertising for bids, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, it is necessary to purchase parts for the repair of American La France Apparatus, and

Whereas, said parts can be purchased from only one concern doing business in the City of Patland, and

Whereas, no advantage would be gained by advertising for bids, therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Purchasing Agent be and he is hereby authorized to purchase parts for American La France Fire apparatus in the open market without advertising for bids therefor in amount not to exceed \$1,200.00.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to draw warrants in payment of the expenditures authorized in Section 1 of this Ordinance when demands therefor are presented properly approved by the Commission. In charge of the department for which said parts are purchased.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: The American La France Fire Apparatus parts authorized in this ordinance are urgently needed for the repair of fire apparatus and must be purchased without delay and in order to do so it is necessary that this ordinance become effective immediately; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
