

Ordinance No. 5111

An ordinance to change and re-establish the curb lines of Third Street, from Ash Street to Ankeny Street.

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable so as to agree with existing improvement of Third Street, from the center line of Ash Street to the center line of Ankeny Street, to widen the roadway from an average of 70 feet in width as now established by Ordinance No. 32924, to an average of 83 feet in width, therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the curb lines of Third Street, from the center line of Ash Street to the center line of Ankeny Street be and the same are hereby changed and re-established at 12 feet east from and parallel to the west property line and 15 feet west of and parallel to the east property line of said Third Street.
