## ORDINANCE No. 187369

\*Authorize contract with Sergeants Towing, Inc. for abandoned vehicle towing and storage services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In accordance with Chapter 3.98 of Portland City Code, the Towing Board of Review recommends that City Council approve the Contract for Abandoned Vehicle Towing and Storage Services in a form substantially similar to the contract attached as Exhibit 1.
- 2. Following a competitive selection process, the Towing Board of Review found Sergeants Towing, Inc. to be the most qualified proposer for the Contract for Abandoned Vehicle Towing and Storage Services.
- 3. Sergeants Towing, Inc. was approved by the Towing Board of Review following a thorough, competitive application process to determine its fitness to perform the duties of this contract. The application process included examination of Sergeant's business practices, criminal and DMV records checks of all employees and owners of the company. All tow trucks and storage facilities were inspected for compliance with contract requirements.
- 4. The formula yields a per-vehicle fee of \$123.75 to be paid by Sergeant's Towing, Inc. to the Abandoned Auto Program in the Bureau of Transportation. This fee is effective until December 31, 2015, when it will be revised based on the published AMM price. Fees will be adjusted once every six months in accordance to published AMM prices over the duration of the contract.
- 5. The Bureau of Transportation has a high-confidence estimate that tow fees from this contract will generate approximately \$165,000 in Abandoned Auto Fee revenues and \$6,000 in City Service Fee revenues for 2015, which are passed through to the Bureau of Transportation. Revenue projects for subsequent years will be impacted by several factors, including regular AMM price adjustments.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to enter into a contract for towing, storage and disposal of abandoned vehicles with Sergeants Towing, Inc. in a form substantially similar to that attached to this ordinance as Exhibit 1.
- b. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute amendments to the contract described in subsection a.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the current contract will expire September 30, 2015 and a new contract is necessary to provide uninterrupted service; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
