Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The proposed legislation is to update Procurement Code to conform to new state law and make technical corrections for PCC 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68.

During the 2014 legislative session, the Oregon Legislature passed other legislation which revised portions of ORS Chapters 279A, 279B and 279C collectively known as the "Public Contracting Code." Some of these changes have taken effect and are being codified at this time. Additionally, housekeeping changes and minor technical corrections have been included as part of this update. The substantive changes include the following in PCC 5.33: The attached Exhibit A (Chapter 5.33), Exhibit B (Chapter 5.34) and Exhibit C (Chapter 5.68) detail the substantive changes and revisions to its Code in order to make the necessary technical corrections to be effective immediately.
