

ORDINANCE No. 187375

Authorize a grant agreement with Legacy Health to support the construction of the Unity Center for Behavioral Health in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:


1. Legacy Health has entered into a Joint Operating Agreement with Adventist Health, Kaiser Permanent, and Oregon Health & Science University to develop and operate a dedicated behavioral health hospital to include 101 acute inpatient beds and a psychiatric emergency department. This new facility will be located in the Legacy Holladay Park facility in the Convention Center district; and
2. It is anticipated that creation of access to a dedicated psychiatric emergency service center will support the City of Portland's goals to facilitate the implementation of provisions in the Settlement Agreement between the City of Portland and the United States Department of Justice which require the City to work with appropriate partners to establish one or more psychiatric emergency centers for both walk-in treatment and first responders who are transporting individuals experiencing mental health crisis; and
3. Following standard budgeting processes, including public review and testimony, the Portland City Council approved its FY16 operating budget which included a special appropriation of \$500,000 to support the construction of the Unity Center for Behavioral Health;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to execute a grant agreement with Legacy Health in a form that substantially conforms to the agreement attached as Exhibit A in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.
- b. The City Council hereby waives the competitive application process for grants as required in FIN 2.04 – Budget.
