# ORDINANCE No. 187376

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$1,189,790 and appropriate \$300,000 for FY 2015-16 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative FY 2015 Competitive Grant to address the issue of unsubmitted sexual assault kits at the Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

# The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City applied to the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for the National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative (SAKI) FY 2015 Competitive Grant on May 6, 2015;
- 2. The Office of Justice Programs has notified the City that it will award a grant, in the form of a cooperative agreement, for the National SAKI FY 2015 Competitive Grant to the City in the amount of \$1,189,790;
- 3. The Office of Justice Programs will reimburse the City a maximum of \$1,189,790 for program expenses incurred by the Police Bureau and its subrecipient, Multnomah County;
- 4. The grant period is October 1, 2015, through September 30, 2018;
- 5. No match is required by this grant; and
- 6. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the award of the grant funds from DOJ.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from OJP for the National SAKI FY 2015 Competitive Grant in the amount of \$1,189,790 and to execute the grant agreement.
- b. The FY 2015-16 budget is hereby amended as follows:

## **GRANTS FUND**

Fund - 217

Business Area - PL

Bureau Program Expenses - \$300,000

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by OJP for the National SAKI FY 2015 Competitive Grant, #2015-AK-BX-K020, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from OJP. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
