## ORDINANCE No. 187377

\* Accept a grant from the Oregon Military Department Office of Emergency Management for their Emergency Management Performance Grant Program in the amount of \$387,782 to administer an integrated all hazard emergency management program for the City (Ordinance)

## The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Military Department Office of Emergency Management's Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) Program provides financial and technical assistance through their Fiscal Year 16 grant for the development of an all hazard emergency management capability to promote planning, response, exercise, training and community outreach.
- 2. Grant funds are budgeted for one half of the cost of three Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) positions, one half of the annual rent for PBEM office space, one half the cost of Technology Services for the Emergency Coordination Center/PBEM, and one half of the Public Alerts hosting contract cost.
- 3. City of Portland matching funds in the amount of \$387,782 shall be in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY15/16 budget of Portland Bureau of Emergency Management.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland an Emergency Management Agency Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) program in the amount of \$387,782 and to execute the award.
- b. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- c. The Director of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Office of Emergency Management for the Emergency Management Agency Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG), grant number 15-544, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay is likely to impair the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effective from and after its passage by Council.
