## **ORDINANCE NO.** 187383

\* Authorize disposal of a usable surplus WWI US Model 1918 trench knife and authorize the Portland Police Bureau to proceed with donation of the property to the National WWI Museum and Memorial (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau has and wishes to dispose of a WWI US Model 1918 trench knife (knife).
- 2. The National WWI Museum and Memorial (Museum) requests the donation of the knife.
- 3. The Museum is the United States' federally-designated museum for the global history of World War l, and is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.
- 4. The Museum has been collecting World War I materials since 1920 and has worked with many police departments to preserve historical objects.
- 5. City Code 5.36, Disposition of Surplus Property, authorizes disposal of surplus property.
- 6. Specific to Subsection 5.36.010 F, Exempt Property, Council approval is required for the disposal of items of historical value by donation.
- 7. Council declares that it is in the interest of the City and the Museum to effect this transaction as soon as possible so that the Museum may receive this donation of surplus property as quickly as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Portland Police Bureau to donate the WWI US Model 1918 trench knife to the National WWI Museum and Memorial.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists as it is important for the benefit of the Museum and the City to effect a complete removal of the surplus property and to determine the final disposition without additional delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


