

ORDINANCE No. 187384

*Extend contract with Gillespie, Prudhon & Associates, Inc. for on-call radio system design extend through December 31, 2016 not to exceed \$80,000 for the public safety radio system replacement project (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002882)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On July 18, 2012, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 185499 authorizing sixty-six on-call contracts, including Contract No. 30002882 with Gillespie, Prudhon & Associates, Inc. for on-call radio system design services.
2. The City seeks to extend contract 30002882 through December 31, 2016 in order to ensure continuity of support for the ongoing public safety radio system replacement.
3. The estimated cost for the additional on-call services through December 31, 2016 is approximately \$80,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute a contract amendment, provided it is approved as to form by the City Attorney, to extend the term of the contract through December 31, 2016 and increase the contract not-to-exceed value by \$80,000.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the solicitation will create delays in the schedule and final implementation of the PSSRP – BTS Radio System Replacement project; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
