OREGON STATE SUPREME COURT, Salem, Oregon:

THEODORE JORDAN, young Negro worker, now under death sentence in the Oregon State Penitentiary, was framed on purely circumstantial evidence and on "confessions" forced from him under the most brutal and inhuman third-degree torture.

☐ Jordan was framed because he is a Negro, because he was an unemployed worker and because of a previous prison record.

☐ We, therefore demand that the Oregon State Supreme Court reverse the verdict of the Klamath Falls Court and that the innocent Theodore Jordan be immediately and unconditionally released.
