## RESOLUTION No. 37159

Direct the Office of Management and Finance to develop office space rates for specific Cityowned or City-leased facilities located in the Central Business District to achieve rate equalization (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the City of Portland owns, maintains, or leases eight facilities in the City's downtown core for the primary purpose of providing office space for City employees; and

WHEREAS, currently the office space rates in each of the City-owned facilities vary, ranging from \$13.83 per square foot to \$34.28 per square foot; and

WHEREAS, City policies prioritize the locating of City employees in City-owned or leased buildings first, and secondarily in non-City owned buildings listed in the National Historic Register; and

WHEREAS, OMF currently calculates office space rates separately for each of the buildings it owns and bureaus pay market rates for office space they lease; and

WHEREAS, the office space rates in City-owned and leased facilities vary based on market conditions, lease terms, and individual building characteristics and costs; and

WHEREAS, OMF's current building specific cost based rate model results in less long-term cost predictability and stability for tenants than other cost recovery rate models; and

WHEREAS, an office space rate equalization plan provides greater cost certainty and predictability to City bureaus and other tenants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Office of Management and Finance (OMF), in collaboration with the City Budget Office shall develop an office space rate methodology for City-owned and leased facilities in the Central Business District to achieve rate equalization; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, OMF shall develop a schedule to achieve equalized office space rates no later than FY 2020-21.
