The other day I was listening to the Editor of "Street Roots" talk about the houseless on our streets and he mentioned that last year we had 50 people die on our streets for being homeless. I was not surprised by that figure but it still saddens one who has been fighting for the houseless through 3 mayors. So "What's your Story Mayor Hales?"

Ten year plan down the tubes after spending 10s of millions on affordable housing, a smoke and mirrors approach or many of us know it as trickle down economics. Affordable housing has nothing to do with getting people off the streets. I live in an apartment complex, some tenants are receiving notices to move because the new owner wants lots more rent. I congratulate your limited efforts to do something about this madness, but it is not enough. Here are things that might be done:

1. A resolution by this council that all non cause evictions be stopped for 120 days pending extensive hearings by this council.

2. Rent control on some level, let the battle happen and take the best compromise.

3. The \$25,000 fee to demolish a home be raised to price of the home; want to destroy it, pay the going cost.

4. Have a community commission/committee to decide if the replacement housing will have any effect on the neighborhood and cause rents to go up

faster than normal. What we are concerned with here is the concept of gentrification.

There is more you can do, but you five are smarter than the rest of us and you have very bright staff, by the way mayor, congratulations on appointing Josh as your COS, I like him---don't always agree but he is a noble person.

I am very aware that we are in a political season and a majority of you are up for reelection and this is a good time to demand that you actually do something instead of just looking at your watch and thinking, "Will he ever shut up." You heard from many last week that they will be watching this Emergency Ordinance." It will take good will, not words but action. We will support you where we can and know we are guided by a simple concept, "Does this action help or hurt the most vulnerable among us?"

And the report comes as Multnomah County and the city of Portland start are **revising their joint plan to combat homelessness,** agreeing to pool money in a way they haven't been able to before. This report also comes in **the midst of a lawsuit and code-enforcement fight over Right 2 Dream Too,** which has provided a safe place to bed down for hundreds of people since it planted itself in a vacant lot in Chinatown (invited by the owner) in late 2011. "It's the idea that homelessness is not just about public safety," Bayer says. "We're talking about a health care issue. We should be able to prevent 56 people from dying homeless. And we know that's an undercount.... If we collect data over a number of years, and draw trends, we'll be able to take the next step, whether that's creating more prevention services or leverage to get more money for housing."

This isn't just happening in Portland. It's happening all over the country.
