Program

I am pleased to submit for your consideration and acceptance a report from students participating in the Planning and Leadership Across City Environments (PLACE) Program at Catlin Gabel. This program gives high school students the opportunity to explore how citizens can relate to a city's urban environment through planning and leadership.

During the summer, students are introduced to urban studies, and learn about civics, sustainability, leadership, economics, statistics, writing, sociology, urban planning and design, qualitative research and analysis, and environmental studies. The goal of this project was to make public spaces within Portland more youth-friendly and increase the youth involvement in the planning and use of these spaces.
