I am pleased to submit for your consideration and acceptance a report from students participating in the Planning and Leadership Across City Environments (PLACE) Program at Catlin Gabel. This program gives high school students the opportunity to explore how citizens can relate to a city's urban environment through planning and leadership.

During the summer, students are introduced to urban studies, and learn about civics, sustainability, leadership, economics, statistics, writing, sociology, urban planning and design, qualitative research and analysis, and environmental studies. The goal of this project was to make public spaces within Portland more youth-friendly and increase the youth involvement in the planning and use of these spaces. With this goal in mind, the group created a document outlining best practices for engaging youth in the planning and creating of spaces to be used by architects, designers and planners, and developed an app for teens to connect with each other to discuss public space.

I hope that through this presentation, the Council can learn more about the work of this fantastic program, and the students presenting can learn more about the work of the Council.

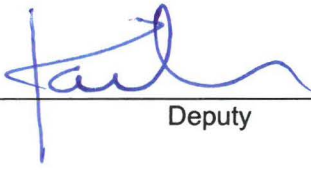
