ORDINANCE NO. 187397

* Apply for and accept a grant in the amount of \$37,500 from the Oregon Department of Transportation and appropriate \$30,000 for overtime reimbursement for the FY2016 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division notified the City that it will award a grant in the amount of \$37,500 to assist the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program (DISP).
- 2. The Portland Police Bureau wishes the City to apply for and accept the ODOT Transportation Safety Division DISP grant for Federal Fiscal Year 2015-16.
- 3. The City will be reimbursed for Portland Police Bureau officers' overtime worked on this program.
- 4. ODOT reimburses officer and sergeant overtime at their actual overtime rates per hour for activities specified toward this grant program.
- 5. Local match in the amount of \$112,500 is required by matching straight-time hours, which will be funded by existing bureau General Fund appropriation.
- 6. The grant period is October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016. Work on the grant may not begin until the award document is fully executed by all parties.
- 7. The Council declares an emergency exists so as not to unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Oregon Department of Transportation for a grant in the amount of \$37,500.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland the subsequent grant award in the amount of \$37,500 from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the 2015-16 DUII Intensive Supervision Program.

d. With the acceptance of the grant award, the FY 2015-16 budget will be amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217

Business Area - PL

Bureau Program Expenses - \$30,000

- e. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- f. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by ODOT for the 2016 DUII Intensive Supervision Program, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so as not to unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
