Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division has notified the City that it will award a grant for the 2016 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program (DISP) to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$37,500.

Portland Police Bureau officers and sergeants will be reimbursed at their actual overtime rate per hour for time worked on the grant program.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The total grant award is \$37,500, which will be divided between FY16 and FY17. At this time, the City will appropriate \$30,000 into the Grant Fund. This grant comes with a match obligation of \$112,500 which will be funded by the Police Bureau's General Fund appropriation.

Community impacts and community involvement:

There are no legal or controversial issues. There is no voluntary citizen participation. There are no links to current City policies. Traffic Division personnel will work with the DISP Director and case managers, Multnomah County Department of Community Justice, and other local law enforcement agencies, as well as ODOT, while working on the grant program items.
