## ORDINANCE NO. 187398

\* Authorize application to Oregon Impact for a grant in the amount of \$80,000 for overtime reimbursement for participation in DUII High Visibility Enforcement events during Federal FY 2015-2016 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Police Bureau would like to apply for the Oregon Impact DUII Overtime Enforcement Grant for Federal Fiscal Year 2015-16.
- 2. Oregon Impact reimburses officer overtime at a rate of \$65.00 per hour for enforcement activities specified towards High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) patrol.
- 3. Oregon Impact requires that agencies receiving funds participate in two National Highway Traffic Safety Administration pre-determined HVE national events with Oregon Association of Chiefs of Police and the Oregon State Police; Christmas 2015/New Year 2016 and Labor Day 2016.
- 4. Oregon Impact requires that agencies initiate HVE news media informing the public what the HVEs are about; both pre- and post- media notification is required.
- 5. Oregon Impact requires that agencies complete and submit an *Oregon Impact DUII Overtime Enforcement Report* each month, noting individual office reports for each shift and include copies of pre- and post-media releases.
- 6. Local match is required by matching straight-time enforcement hours, which will be funded by existing bureau General Fund appropriation.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to make application to Oregon Impact for a grant in the amount of \$80,000.
- b. The Chief of Police is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Chief's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of critical deadlines in the grant application process. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
