

ORDINANCE No. 187405

Amend 2013 - 2018 Contract for Vehicle Towing and Storage Services to correct the procedure for Portland Streetcar, Inc. tows. (Ordinance; amend Contract Nos. 30003497, 30003504-30003508 and 30003511- 30003521)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. At the recommendation of the Towing Board of Review, pursuant to Chapter 3.98 of the Code, Council approved the contract for vehicle towing and storage services for the October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2018 term.
2. The parties to this contract are the City of Portland, Oregon, the Port of Portland, Oregon Department of Transportation, Multnomah County, City of Fairview, Portland Streetcar, Inc., TriMet and Tow Contractors listed in Exhibit B.
3. Portland Streetcar, Inc. ("PSI") requested a change to the previous payment policy by which PSI paid the cost of each tow from the streetcar tracks. The amendment clarifies that the cost of towing is now the responsibility of the vehicle owner.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to amend the 2013-2018 Contract for Vehicle Towing and Storage Services (Contract Nos. 30003497, 30003504-30003508, and 30003511- 30003521) in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.




