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Thank you Commissioner Novick and Members of the Commission for this opportunity to give testimony for the traffic island that St. Johns calls Ivy Island.

I LOVE Ivy Island our St. Johns Gateway and I do NOT want to see it destroyed or given away to Mr. Bolouri.

The vacation is justified by the St Johns Lombard Plan. The St Johns Lombard Plan is a thing of beauty, it has three important points that matter to this development: NUMBER ONE, in creating our Gateway, there needs to be improved visibility into the downtown business district, or at the very least, we should not block the visibility we already have; TWO, there must be improved pedestrian walkability along this east/west corridor, and NUMBER THREE, this intersection here at N. Charleston and Lombard needs to be made safe – right now it's a blind corner and we need to make it safer. Simple, elegant, and no parking or traffic impact on James John Elementary School.

Let's look over here at Mr. Bolouri's plan. His development fails on all but one count – it makes the Charleston intersection safer, but that's ALL that it does, there's not improved visibility into our downtown core, in fact there's now a tall brick building blocking our view into downtown! No improvement, an outright fail. In terms of improved east/west walkability for pedestrians, all we have is just this sidewalk that goes along the perimeter of Mr. Bolouri's development and runs right next to the traffic. The Pedestrian is exposed to the traffic on Lombard RT30. No improvement, exactly how we have it now. So it fails, on all but that one point.

On these grounds alone, Mr. Bolouri has not earned the right for us to give him our public land, our Ivy Island and St. Johns Gateway. I would like to see us KEEP Ivy Island, KEEP the slip lane... Perhaps one day we will bring the STREET CAR back to downtown St Johns and on that day I would be happy to use our public lands for that reason. But right now, it's not worth it. Without doing a thing to Ivy Island, we have visibility into our downtown and a unique Gateway into St Johns! In our mad dash towards progress and density, we want ST JOHNS TO STILL LOOK LIKE ST JOHNS and have a proper Gateway!

The Charleston/Lombard corner is unsafe because a building blocks sight on a curve and because cars speed as they enter the Slip Lane. But once they tear down the old Value Giant building, all it would take to fix this is to set any new building back FOUR FEET farther than current regulations. If that happens it will be safe. The problem of speed can be dealt with more conventionally: such as a pedestrian stoplight. We can put a man on the moon and a woman in the space station, we can CERTAINLY find a way to slow down traffic and make that corner safe.

Included is a growing community petition of over 400 neighbors who feel as I do. Save Ivy Island!

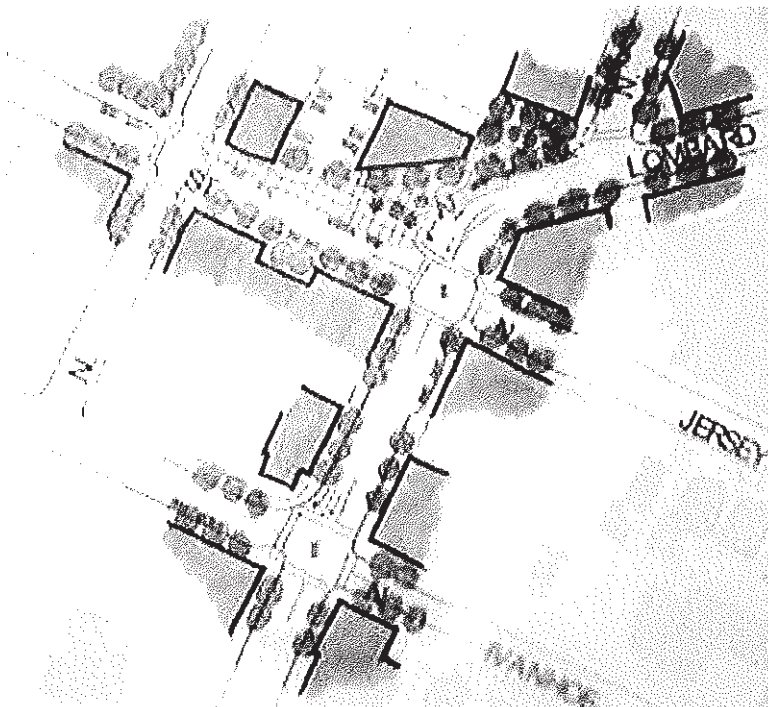
Town Center Gateway Intersection Improvements

There are two “front doors” or gateways to St. Johns for visitors arriving by car from outside the area: the Philadelphia/ Ivanhoe and Lombard/ Richmond intersections. Both are major traffic portals as well. While previous planning efforts have improved the appearance and function of these intersections as gateways through landscaping, the current designs have also tended to obscure sight lines into the commercial core that lies behind the gateways. To help support revitalization of the business district through improving the visual as well physical connection into the commercial core, consistent with the plan objectives, the recommendations include new alignment concepts at both intersection locations.

Lombard/Richmond Gateway

Sight lines into the town center core from Lombard at Richmond are complicated by the bend in Lombard as it passes by the Lombard/Richmond gateway. Furthermore, the right-turn lane from Lombard westbound into the commercial core curves around a large radius corner that obscures sight distances with pedestrians crossing Lombard further to the west, near James John Elementary School and encourages speeding.

The new design concept shifts the island to the north and merges it with the sidewalk area, creating a more traditional right angle intersection alignment. Eastbound traffic on Lombard entering the town center core would still have a free right turn, but the turn movement would be around a tighter radius corner that will slow traffic speeds and improve sight distances down Lombard. The space occupied by the former island could be designed to allow for more active pedestrian use and improve sight lines into the commercial core for traffic approaching the intersection from the east. There are no capacity impacts anticipated with this realignment. Specific design details still need to be developed through a design engineering process with public involvement.

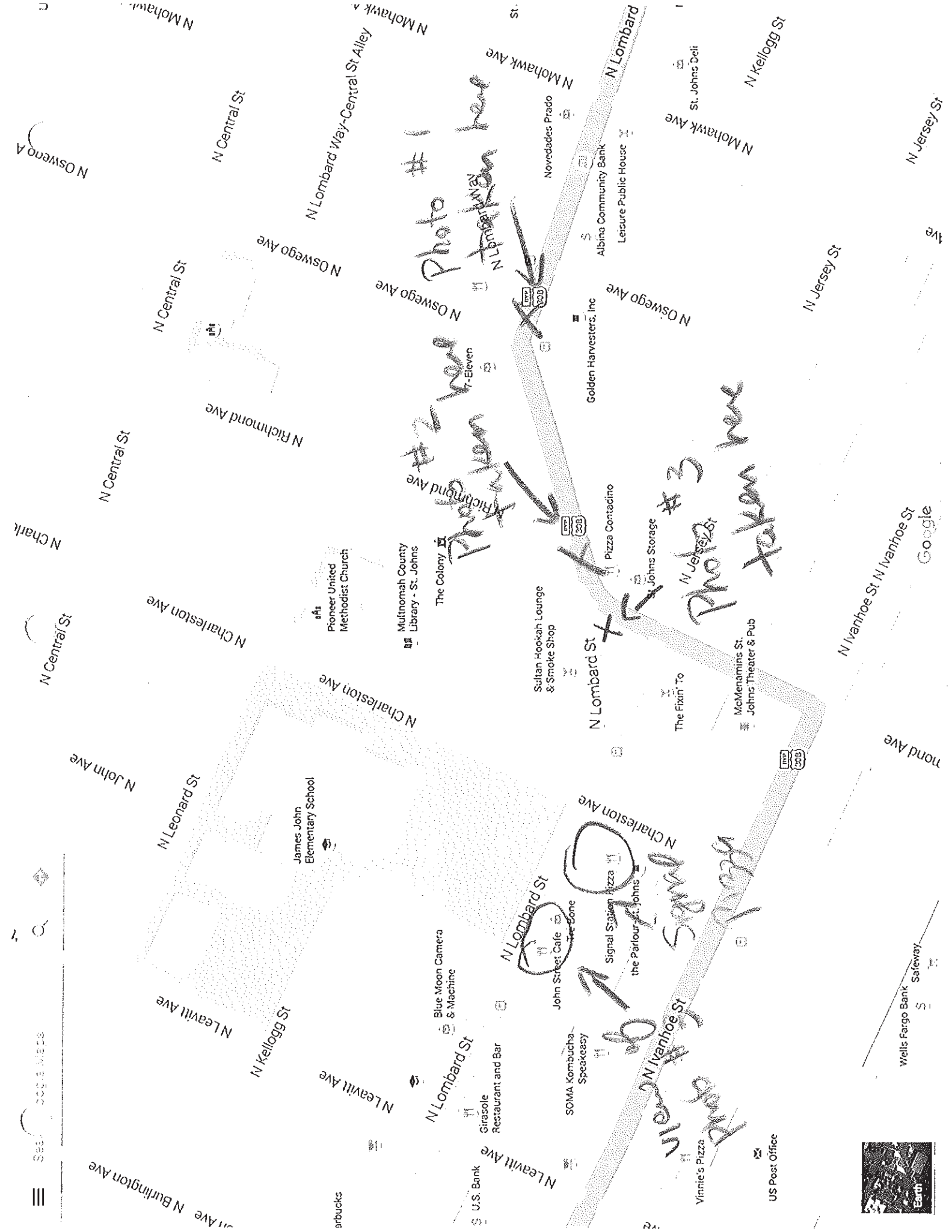

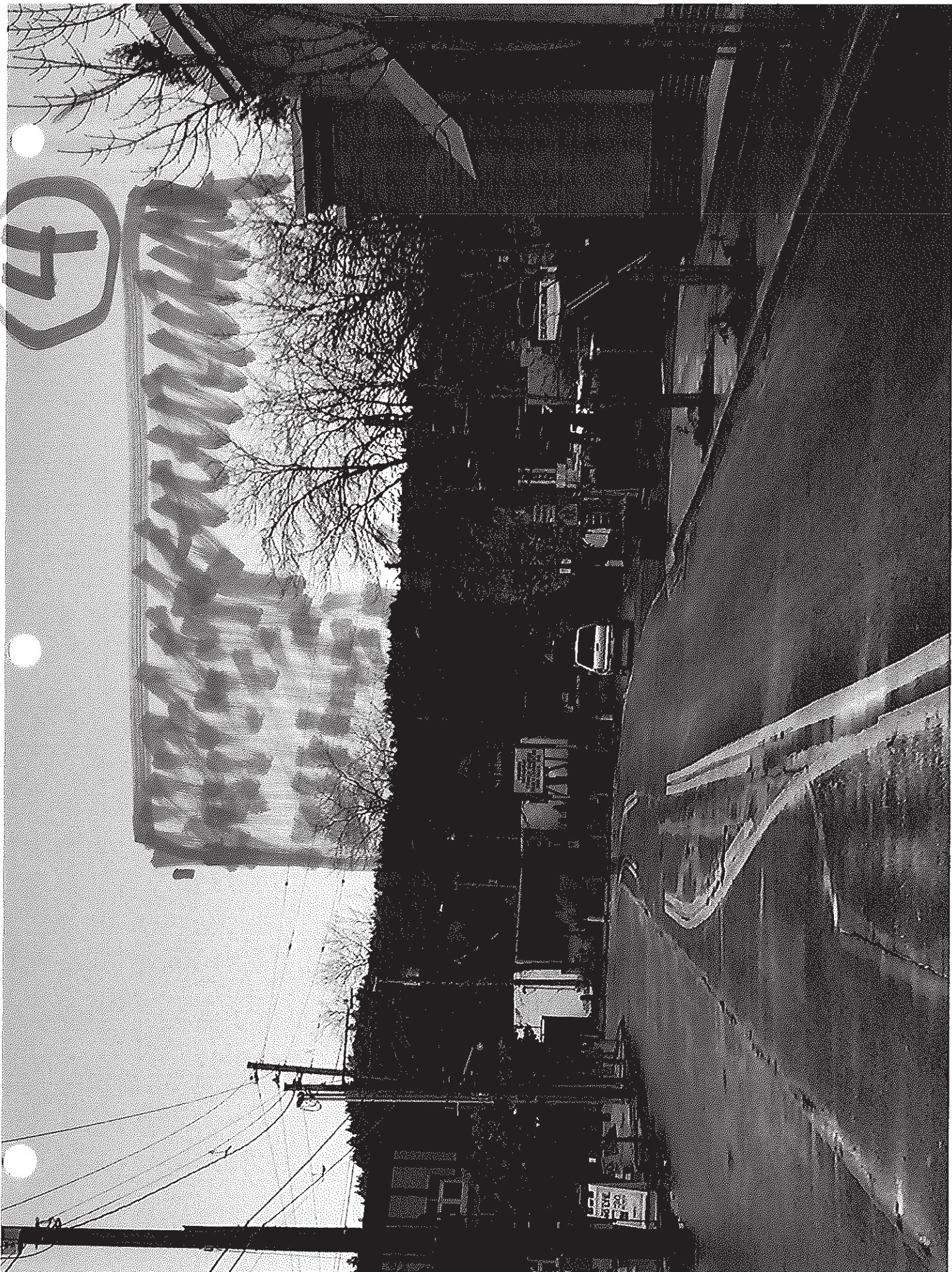

Gerry Howard's Letter to the St Johns Review

Dear Editor,

As an original member of the Citizen Working Group (CWO) for the St. Johns/Lombard Plan, I am very interested in the discussion regarding the proposed Union at St. Johns project located at Lombard and Richmond which includes a redesign of the traffic island such that the city will allow the slip lane to be removed and the building to intrude into the vacated space. As noted by others, this will effectively construct a 4-story wall right at a strategic entrance to the business district. This was not the intent of the CWG. While the Plan itself does not discuss this intersection at length, the issue was an important topic of discussion at multiple CWG meetings. The design ultimately adopted as an element of the Plan came about due to feedback received from both St. Johns residents and businesses. At that time, the concerns revolved around excessive traffic speeds, crossing safety and the importance of the intersection as an iconic entry point into the business district. Many business owners felt that when through traffic was diverted off of Lombard and onto Ivanhoe, the business district suffered tremendously. With entry into the slip lane being located to the east, it was opined that potential shoppers were already committed to the Richmond / Ivanhoe bypass before they even realized there was a business district. By eliminating the slip and installing traffic signals at the intersection, drivers would be able to see the business district while waiting for the signal to change. As I recall, the consensus of the CWG was that the slip lane would be removed, but the plaza would remain (and be enlarged). Obviously a brick wall would stymie the intent.

Please note that in addition to the Plan document itself, there were multiple studies prepared to provide background information used in the formulation of the Plan. The background work was performed by the Bureau of Planning along with contractors engaged by the City. Members of the CWG reviewed a large amount of information over a 2-1/2 year period, including the various studies and reports prepared by contractors, the Portland Harbor Industrial Lands Study (Part One and Part Two), and the St. Johns Truck Study, along with feedback generated by Community Outreach efforts; Neighborhood Walks, Open Houses, Visioning Workshops, and input from the affected neighborhood and business associations.

Background information regarding the redesign of the intersection and of Ivy Island can be found in the Urban Development Concept Report prepared in May 2003 by Lennertz Coyle & Associates along with (among others) E. D. Hovee & Company. This report has several appendixes including a Project Memorandum prepared by E. D. Hovee with the subject line "Assessment of St. Johns Waterfront Industrial Areas." That 8-page memo itself incorporates various appendixes, including one identified as "Chapter 3: Alternatives Evaluation." On page 3-26 of that report is a more detailed discussion of the proposed re-design of the traffic island (Ivy Island) with several potential alternatives. Option C is the recommended design and an illustration of that option is found on page 3-26. Note the wording of the recommendation is as follows: "The project would remove the existing traffic island and shift the travel lanes on Lombard Street to the south. The gain in property to the north should be incorporated to (sic) a large
