

**ORDINANCE No. 187 418**

Adopt a Waste Reduction Plan and accept and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro to receive Metro Waste Reduction Challenge Funds of \$283,408 and \$336,189 for the Recycle at Work Program in FY 15-16 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. Metro has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant of Metro Waste Reduction Challenge Funds and the Recycle at Work Program in FY 15-16 to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability in the amount of \$283,408 and \$336,189.
2. Funds continue to support mutual regional and citywide goals for improved efforts in waste reduction and recycling volume.
3. The funding of \$596,000 was appropriated in the FY 2015-16 Adopted Budget for the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability. The remaining fund is being appropriated in this ordinance for the Grants Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Metro, Attachment 1, for the Metro and Local Government Annual Waste Reduction Plan and the Recycle at Work Program in the amount of \$283,408 and \$336,189 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement substantially similar to Attachment 1 for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2015-16 budget is hereby amended as follows for the remaining fund:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217

Business Area – PN

Bureau Program Expenses – \$23,597

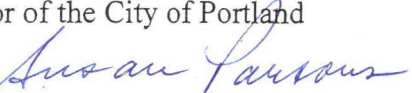
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Metro for Contract No. 30004827/933608, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.
