\*Pay claim of Jerry L. Johnson in the sum of \$10,000 poolving the Bureau of Transportation. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Jerry L. Johnson has filed a workers' compensation claim with the City for an on-the-job injury sustained on July 8, 2011 while employed by the Bureau of Transportation.
- 2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The claim was found compensable. There are issues that are in litigation on the compensable claim. There is future exposure for additional benefits under state workers' compensation law. Therefore, in order to compromise and eliminate future exposure for benefits and reduce expenses to the City's workers' compensation fund, it is prudent to resolve the claim for the litigated issues at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$10,000, subject to the claimant executing settlement documents in a form to be approved by the City Attorney, and contingent on all required approvals of those documents.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks in the total amount of \$10,000 made payable to Gary Borden, claimant's attorney.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute any necessary payment authorizations in the total amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
