ORDINANCE NO. 187440

*Authorize application to the Oregon Department of Transportation for grants in the amount of up to \$7 million for four non-highway transportation infrastructure projects: Flanders City Greenway, Red Electric Trail, Streetcar Vehicle Purchase, Naito Crossing (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Through the *Connect*Oregon program, the Oregon Department of Transportation is soliciting non-highway infrastructure projects that help ensure Oregon's transportation system is strong, diverse, and efficient and promotes economic development.
- 2. Working with stakeholders, the Bureaus of Transportation and Parks and Recreation identified four priority projects (Attachment A) for submittal to the *Connect*Oregon grant fund.
- 3. The projects identified improve safety and multi-modal access and promote economic development by providing non-auto access to job centers.
- 4. The attached list of projects (Attachment A) was developed with the assistance of the City's Bicycle, Pedestrian and Freight Advisory Committees.
- Local match in the amount of 30% of total project cost will be provided from various sources including Transportation and Parks System Development Charges and Portland Streetcar.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Portland Bureau of Transportation is hereby authorized to make application to the Oregon Department of Transportation for grants in the amount of up to \$7 million.
- b. The Director of the Portland Bureau of Transportation is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grants are due immediately; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
