Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On May 28, 2014, the Council authorized the execution of an Intergovernmental Agreement for Levee Analysis Cost-Sharing ("the IGA," Ordinance No. 186599).
- 2. The formation of a joint contracting authority for the drainage district parties to the IGA and a change in the Loan repayment schedule have made it necessary to amend the IGA.
- 3. These modifications to the IGA will not increase the cost of the City's obligations thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Director of the Office of Management and Finance is authorized to execute an amendment to the IGA in a form substantially similar to the draft amendment attached as Exhibit A.
