## ORDINANCE No. 187458

\* Waive bond requirement of Code Section 5.08.160 D to allow City to pay accrued leave to spouse of deceased employee (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Code Section 5.08.160 sets forth the procedures for delivery of checks payable to deceased persons. Subsection D of that Section provides that before a check may be delivered to an heir or next of kin who lives out of state, the heir or next of kin must sign a hold harmless agreement and post a bond to defend and indemnify the City, its officers, agents and employees against any claim, suit, action or judgment arising out of the delivery or payment of the checks.
- 2. Susan Ashenfelter, an employee of the Bureau of Development Services, died October 15, 2015. Upon her death, Ms. Ashenfelter was entitled to accrued leave in the amount of \$709.52.
- 3. Ms. Ashenfelter's spouse resides in the state of Washington. Under City Code, the spouse is required to sign a hold harmless agreement and post a bond to receive the check payable to Ms. Ashenfelter. Ms. Ashenfelter's spouse has already signed a hold harmless agreement.
- 4. It is desirable to deliver the check for accrued leave to Ms. Ashenfelter's spouse without the time and expense in obtaining a bond.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The requirement of Portland City Code Section 5.08.160 D for a bond shall be waived to allow the City to pay accrued leave to Ms. Ashenfelter's spouse without receiving a bond from the spouse.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in delivery of the check to the deceased employee's spouse would create financial hardship; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
