ORDINANCE No. 187451

*Extend contract with Bowman Systems, L.L.C. for five years and increase the Software and Services Master Agreement for hosted software and related services by \$1,250,000 for a not-to-exceed contractual total of \$1,750,000 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30003215)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City entered into Contract No. 30003215 with Bowman Systems, L.L.C., effective September 1, 2012, to provide a license and related services for Bowman's hosted software used by the Bureau of Housing for management of human services and related data, including homeless populations.
- 2. The City wishes to extend the term of the Contract for an additional five years to allow continued use of this software.
- 3. The original contractual amount was \$500,000. With the proposed amendment, the not-to-exceed value of the Contract shall be increased by \$1,250,000 to cover the additional five years, to a contractual total of \$1,750,000.
- 4. This software is shared with other local agencies, including Multnomah County SUNSS/CSD (the Schools Uniting Neighborhoods [SUN] Service System and Community Services Division), Multnomah County DVCO (Domestic Violence Coordination Office), Washington County, and Clackamas County. The identified agencies reimburse the City for the costs associated with this Contract via intergovernmental agreements with the City and direct payments to Bowman Systems.
- 5. This Contract will continue to be funded by HUD Continuum of Care HMIS (Homeless Management Information System) grant monies.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The City's Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute a Contract amendment, provided that it is approved as to form by the City Attorney, to extend the term and to increase the not-to-exceed value of the Contract.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the City needs to act promptly in order to ensure continuity of the software license, compliance with federal funding programs, and continued provision of housing and support services to the City's homeless and at-risk population. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
