Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) is seeking authority for the City's Chief Procurement Officer to execute a fifth amendment to contract #32003215 with Bowman Systems, L.L.C., to provide a license and related services for Bowman's hosted software used by the Bureau of Housing for management of human services and related data, including homeless populations.
