

An Ordinance accepting certain property for the widening of N.E. 36th Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for the widening of N.E. 36th Avenue.

Commencing at the northwest corner of lot 1, block 7, Hancock Street Addition; thence east along the northerly line of said lot a distance of 20 feet; thence south a distance of 20 feet parallel with the westerly line of said lot; thence west a distance of 20 feet parallel with the northerly line of said lot to its westerly line; thence north along the westerly line of said lot a distance of 20 feet to the place of beginning. (Deeded by Ernest C. Sinnett, a single man)

Section 2. That the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to have the deed to the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: It is necessary that this property be immediately opened as a public thoroughfare; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
