TO THE COUNCIL:

On June 24, 2015, Council approved Ordinance Number 187222 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant Lagoon Reconstruction Phase 3/4 Project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000060 on behalf of the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES), with a project construction estimate of \$11,000,000. BES rated the project estimate confidence level as High.

Bids were opened on August 4, 2015, and three (3) bids were received. The low bid from Stellar J Corporation was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that Stellar J Corporation's bid be accepted at the estimated unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$9,923,740.

BES along with Procurement Services, identified five (5) Divisions of Work as potential subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$2,697,100 awarded to subcontractors.

In their bid, Stellar J Corporation indicated their intent to self-perform the following Divisions of Work:

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MWESB participation represents 46.4% or \$1,250,000 of the estimated subcontracting dollars.

- WBE \$1,200,000 performing Hauling Services (Trucking)
- ESB \$50,000 performing Traffic Control Services (TPDT)

Stellar J Corporation is located in Woodland, Washington, and is not a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and

EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center WBS E07146.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
