ORDINANCE No. 187466

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for City participation in the County's Healthy Streets Pilot Project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Multnomah County Health Department (County) has initiated an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Portland Bureau of Transportation (City) to provide syringe disposal services which include collection, transportation, and disposal of biohazard material in addition to emergency disposal service calls.
- 2. The above stated services meet the goals and objectives of the City of Portland's Bureau of Transportation.
- 3. A maximum of \$20,000 in City funds will be provided for the above stated services. The period of performance for this IGA is November 1, 2015 to October 31, 2016.
- 4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, as this is the first year of a pilot project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for City participation in the County's Healthy Streets Pilot Project, in a form similar to the IGA attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the services rendered as invoiced by Multnomah County in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay in providing services will negate the effectiveness of the pilot program; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
