

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to advertise for proposals for installing heating system in Lodge at Multnomah Falls, authorizing contract therefor and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the Purchasing Agent do and he is hereby authorized to advertise for proposals for installing heating system in Lodge at Multnomah Falls in strict accordance with plans and specifications therefor filed in the office of the Purchasing Agent on the 26th day of December, 1924, which plans and specifications are hereby adopted.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Commissioner of Finance be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for said work in accordance with said plans and specifications, provided, however, that in case no bids are received which are satisfactory to the Council, the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to readvertise therefor such number of times as may be necessary in order to receive satisfactory bids.

Section 3: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this; it is necessary that said building be available for use as soon as possible, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
