Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance will close OMF Risk Management file Number 2013 0295 01G, which arises from property damage to Michael Jimenez in a sewer backup incident that occurred on April 15, 2013 at 2913 SE 85th Avenue.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This legislation will have no impact on City revenue.

Cost to the City is \$57,920.00. The source of funding is the City's Insurance and Claims Fund. All cost of the settlement is in the current fiscal year. This Ordinance does not amend the budget.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This Ordinance settles a tort claim resulting from property damage at the home of Michael Jimenez following sewer cleaning activities by PBOT maintenance crews in SE Portland on April 15, 2013.

No public involvement or input was sought regarding the Ordinance. The City Attorney's Office and Risk Management have concluded that it is not appropriate to have public involvement in settlement negotiations regarding tort claims or lawsuits against the City.

No future public involvement is anticipated or necessary. Approval by City Council of this Ordinance will fully resolve this tort claim against the City of Portland.
