## **ORDINANCE No.** 187494

\*Delegate authority to the Bureau of Human Resources Director to execute a work-experience agreement with SE Works/Worksource to provide work experience training opportunities to disadvantaged and underserved populations in order for them to transition into long-term employment (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Human Resources manages and coordinates the work-experience and workstudy programs through its Training and Development Program, which includes work opportunities for students; employee training programs; and organizational development.
- 2. SE Works/Worksource is a 501(c)3 not-for-profit organization with an extensive history of successfully engaging multi-barriered, low income, underserved populations to access work opportunities in order to gain long-term employment opportunities.
- 3. The City will benefit from the agreement to provide short-term, temporary work experience to identified participants who will be assigned to job tasks within City bureaus on an as-needed basis. The participants will benefit from learning skills and gaining work experience that will prepare them for employment.
- 4. There is no obligation for the City to hire the work-experience participants once the assignment has ended. The work will not replace or conflict with work performed by regular City employees. There is no direct cost to the City, and SE Works/Worksource will be the Employer of Record.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of Human Resources is authorized to enter into a one-year agreement with SE Works/Worksystems for the purpose of providing short-term work experience to qualified participants.
- b. By mutual agreement between the Human Resources Director and SE Works/Worksource, the agreement may be extended for two additional one-year terms, not to exceed a total of three years.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that the City's Training and Development Program may proceed without interruption; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
