Subject: tree code

This is an email to urge the City of Portland to adopt Audubon Society of Portland's proposed Tree Code reforms .

We cannot let the development industry destroy these trees, and what truly makes Portland a beautiful city. As a temporary stop-gap measure until Title 11 reforms can be developed and adopted, please require inch-for-inch mitigation for cutting large, healthy, non-dangerous and non-nuisance trees ≥ 30 " diameter at breast height "dbh" in development and non-development situations until Title 11 preservation standards can be reformed.

Also, require posting and a 30-day delay before any tree ≥ 30 " dbh is permitted to be cut.
